English	Mathematics
Unit 4 In this unit students will read, view and comprehend texts including simple decodable texts aligned with phonic development. They will engage in shared and independent writing to create short, written imaginative stories, and to retell familiar imaginative stories. They use some learnt vocabulary, basic sentence boundary punctuation and learnt phonic knowledge to spell words.	Unit 4 In this unit students will make connections between number names, numerals and position in the sequence of numbers from zero to at least 20. They will compare the size of collections to at least 20. Students will partition and combine collections up to 10 in different ways, representing these with numbers. They will copy and continue repeating patterns.
Science	HASS (Humanities and Social Sciences) Terms 1 & 2
Unit 4 In this unit students engage in activities from the five contexts of learning: Play, Real-life situations, Investigations, Routines and transitions, and Focused learning and teaching. Students will use their senses to observe and explore the properties and movement of objects.	Unit 2-My Special Places Students will identify, represent and describe the features of familiar places, and suggest ways to care for a special familiar place.
The Arts-Music Terms 1 & 2	Physical Education
Dance-Dancing Characters In this unit students make and respond to dance by exploring characters in stories and rhymes as stimulus.	Unit 4 In this unit, students will perform fundamental movement skills to music. They will explore the elements of movement and describe how their body responds to movement in a performance combining the elements of movement.

Unit 4 In this unit, students identify actions and protective behaviours that keep them safe and healthy in situations where they may encounter medicines, poisons, water and fires.
